

On the 25th of May 2018 was applied to all member states in the European Economic Area (EEA), the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the council of 27 April 2016, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (Genera was applied to all

Lawful Basis for Data Processing and Data Controller

The Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB), is a State University and is considered a legal entity of public law, which is supervised by the state through the Greek Ministry of Education, Research and Religious Affairs.

The AUEB acting by Law No. 4485/2017 (Greek Official Government Gazette 114/A/4-8-2017), by the published Bureaucratic structure of its internal administrative departments (Greek Official Government Gazette 160/A/16-07-1996), by its internal rules of procedure (Greek Official Government Gazette 671/B/30-05-2002) and by the modified regulation of the Master and Doctorate Courses (Greek Official Government Gazette 2093/B/19-06-2017), has the responsibility of establishing, operating and financially administering Programmes for Postgraduate Studies.

In this context, and for performing tasks carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority that has been undertaken by the Higher Educational Institution, the Athens University of Economics and Business becomes Controller of personal data.

Purpose of the Personal Data Processing

The purpose of processing personal data is **for facilitating the submission procedure for entering the Programme for Postgraduate Studies**, according to the applicable law.

In case a person (subject according to applicable law) is selected to participate in a Programme, the subject's data will undergo further processing, **aiming to create and maintain the relevant student registry** of the Programme, which is solely used for the academic operation.

It is highlighted that the AUEB will use this data in order to offer to its current students and alumni informational and consultation services concerning their career path, in addition to following up their professional progress, as law dictates.

It is noted that according to Art.5, section (b) of EC 2016/679 "further processing for archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes shall, in accordance with Article 89(1), not be considered to be incompatible with the initial purposes"

Duration of the processing

Personal data that are collected during the Programme admission process are maintained for as long as the subject is considered a student and for a reasonable time after their graduation and until covering all needs of issuing their certificates, validation of copies of certificates, genuine signature authorisations and, in general, until carrying out all student and citizen requests.

Personal data that are maintained for informational and consultation reasons concerning the professional career path of a student are maintained for **5 years.**

Data transmission and Recipients

The only need of transmission, of any personal data collected in this context, concern only the coverage of requirements of verification of degrees, issue and transmission of certificates and/or copies of degrees. In that case, the recipients are other Institutions, Organisations, Chambers or other entities in Greece or abroad.

In addition, data recipients can be the responsible Agencies of the Ministry of Education, the National Statistical Agency, the Hellenic Quality Assurance and Accreditation Agency (HQA), etc. for which the Data Controller is obliged to issue and send statistical information.

Public Authorities that may receive personal data in the context of a specific research are not considered as data recipients as defined in Art.4, section 9 of EC 2016/679.

The Rights of the Subjects of the Data

It is highlighted that a subject has the **right to access** all personal data that are registered in the electronic application for the admission, and that you maintain **the right to amend or correct** during the applicable period of admission. Furthermore, according to GDPR, a subject has the right to submit a request to the Data Controller for access and correction of its own personal data.

Supervisory Authority

In Greece, the competent Supervisory Authority that you can communicate to submit questions or complaints related to personal data processing issues subject to its responsibilities according to the applicable GDPR provisions is the **Hellenic Data Protection Authority** (www.dpa.gr).
